

Safety Notes

Read all the following Safety Notes before working with this product. These notes include important information about the installation, usage, and maintenance of this product. This product contains no user-serviceable parts. Any reference to servicing in this User Manual will only apply to properly trained Rasha certified technicians. Do not open the housing or attempt any repairs. All applicable local codes and regulations apply to proper installation of this product.

Personal Safety

Avoid direct eye exposure to the light source while the product is on. Always disconnect this product from its power source before servicing. Always connect this product to a grounded circuit to avoid the risk of electrocution. Do not touch this product's housing during operation because it may be very hot.

Rigging

This product is for indoor use only! To prevent risk of fire or shock, do not expose this product to rain or moisture. (IP20) CAUTION: When transferring product from extreme temperature environments, (e.g. cold truck to warm humid ballroom) condensation may form on the internal electronics of the product. To avoid causing a failure, allow product to fully acclimate to the surrounding environment before connecting it to power. Mount this product in a location with adequate ventilation, at least 20 Inches (50 cm) from adjacent surfaces. Make sure there are no flammable materials close to this product while it is operating. Always carry this product by the body. Do not carry from the head.

Power And Wiring

Always make sure you are connecting this product to the proper voltage in accordance with the specifications in this manual or on the product's specification label. Never connect this product to a dimmer pack or rheostat. Never disconnect this product by pulling or tugging on the power cable.

Operation

Do not operate this product if you see damage to the housing, lenses, or cables. Have the damaged parts replaced by an authorized technician at once. To eliminate unnecessary wear and improve its lifespan, during periods of non-use completely disconnect the product from power via breaker or by unplugging it. Do not cover the ventilation slots when operating to avoid internal overheating. Do not aim this product toward the Sun. The lenses could concentrate the solar energy and cause internal overheating. The maximum ambient temperature is 113 °F (45 °C). Do not operate this product at a higher temperature. In case of a serious operating problem, stop using this product immediately!



Power Supply Charger

Each Bullet Zoom has an external auto-ranging charger that works with an input voltage range of 100 to 240 VAC, 50/60 Hz. To determine the power requirements for each Bullet Zoom refer to the label affixed to the product. You can also refer to the Technical Specifications chart in this manual. The listed current rating indicates the maximum current draw during normal operation. Always connect this product to a protected circuit with an appropriate electrical ground to avoid the risk of electrocution or fire. To eliminate unnecessary wear and improve its lifespan, during periods of non-use completely disconnect the product from power via breaker or by unplugging it.



Never connect this product to a rheostat (variable resistor) or dimmer circuit, even if the rheostat or dimmer channel serves only as a 0 to 100% switch.

AC Plug

The Bullet Zoom comes with a power input cord terminated with an Edison Connector (U.S. market). If the power input cord that came with your product has no plug, or if you need to change the Edison plug, use the table below to wire the new plug.

Always mount this product in a safe position and make sure there is adequate room for ventilation, configuration, and maintenance


Rasha recommends using the following general guidelines when mounting this product.

- Bullet zoom it comes with built in magnet surface, you can easily stick over any metal surface. If you need to install over the glass or white surface magnet may leave the black marks over its surface. customer are requested to put a part of fabrik
- When selecting an installation location, consider easy access to this product for operation, programming adjustments, and routine maintenance.
- Make sure to mount this product away from any flammable material as indicated in the Safety Notes.
- Never mount in places where rain, high humidity, extreme temperature changes, or restricted ventilation may affect the product.
- If hanging this product, make sure that the mounting location can support the product's weight. See the Technical Specifications for the weight-bearing requirements of this product.






- Bullet it has 8 dial selector switch A,B,C,D,0,25,50,100 as shown in left side picture
- · A,B,C,D- those stand for the channel or group.
- 0,25,50,100 those stand for brightness
- User can trun the indicator switch clockwise or anti clockwise and pointout towards A,B,C or D
- Once you set the channel A,B,C,D, user can rotrate the indicator switch anti clockwise and set the disired brightness
- 0 will works as turnoff switch, if user set the indicator switch at "0" fixture will compeletely shutdown, it will help the battery drain
- User can manually set the channels/group and set the desired brightness
- Once A,B,C,D group selected or set fixtures on different channel, those different channel group fixture can be accessed and control brightness by IR remote.
- Inorder to access and control the fixture by remote > set or pointout selector switch towards A,B,C or D, If user set or indicator switch towards A, Press "A" button of the remote first then press "Full" or Brightness level buttons(10%,25%,50%,70% or 100%)
- If user set or indicator switch towards B, Press "B" button of the remote first then press "Full" or Brightness level buttons(10%,25%,50%,70% or 100%)
